This month Blue Horizons reaches the grand milestone of 100 issues. To mark this occasion, Peter Beadles, Founder and Former CEO of Reader Offers Ltd, shares the history behind the No. 1 Monthly Cruise Magazine as voted by all leading cruise lines.



Twelve years ago I realised that we had a large number of clients and we were doing little if anything to keep in touch with them. Our idea was to put a newsletter together and send it out quarterly with information about current holiday availability and any news that we felt would be interesting. This newsletter turned into a magazine and was published as "Newsround".

Early editions of Newsround carried a variety of holidays, short city breaks, long haul, short haul and cruising. Even in the early days we came up with some novel holidays. One that springs to mind was during the centenary celebrations by Harley Davidson (2003) we ran a promotion "Take your Harley Home" where we offered Harley owners a trip out on the QE2 with their bikes, bringing them back a few weeks later and giving them time to go to one or more of the USA Harley centenary events.

By the spring of 2005 we were selling only cruises. It felt fitting that a new title should be given, to what was now, a much larger magazine. So Blue Horizons came into being. On a ship visit in 2006 I met the Telegraph Cruise Travel writer Jane Archer. Jane's knowledge of the cruise industry from a passenger point of view, I believe, is unequalled and we were delighted when she agreed to write a monthly article for Blue Horizons. Nine years on I am delighted to say, she is still with us. The number of clients we were now mailing had grown dramatically, also the number of cruise ships available, and itineraries for UK clients

had increased massively. Blue Horizons had become a monthly magazine. A prize crossword was introduced which also continues to this day and is very popular with our readers.

In 2011 Nigel Lingard retired from Fred. Olsen, where as Sales Director, he had a big input into Fred. Olsen cruise destinations and itineraries. Nigel had been instrumental in helping us become the largest agent worldwide for Fred. Olsen Cruise Lines and so we were delighted when he joined us as a Non-Executive Director. As part of his role he writes a monthly piece for Blue Horizons. Nigel also represents us at ABTA where he sits on the Membership Committee.

In 2012 Jennie Bond joined us as our Cruise Miles Ambassador to help promote our loyalty scheme on TV and in the National Press. She is a keen cruiser and you will see her continuing to feature in most editions of Blue Horizons.

In the last couple of years Blue Horizons has "gone digital" so not only can you receive the magazine through the post; it is also available online.

We have moved a long way since the inception of our newsletter. I believe we have a really well put together magazine and with issue 100 now out, I am really proud of what the magazine has become and truly hope you find it enjoyable and useful.

Caribbean, USA & incredible Mardi Gras



Mardi Gras

Mardi Gras - the mere mention of these two words convey thoughts of raucous celebrations, beads flying through the air, and of course, floats parading through the streets of New Orleans!

However, the origins of Mardi Gras can be traced back to medieval Europe, passing through Rome and Venice in the 17th and 18th centuries to the French House of the Bourbons. From these humble beginnings, each year thousands of people become honorary Creoles to celebrate Mardi Gras.

Mardi Gras, which in French translates as Fat Tuesday, is officially the day before Ash Wednesday. As the celebrations in America and across the world have grown larger with each passing year, Mardi Gras has evolved from one day into week long celebrations.

The New Orleans Carnival season starts on 6th January, called "Twelfth Night" and a masked ball is held each year to mark the beginning of New Orleans' Carnival season.

Mardi Gras is about music, parades, picnics, floats and excitement and it's one big holiday in New Orleans! Revellers know to wear costumes or at least dress in purple (justice), green (faith), and gold (power), adorning themselves with long beads caught from the floats of previous parades. The significance of the colours was selected by Rex, the King of Carnival in 1892.

Today, the celebrations are about cultures coming together to celebrate the things that make them unique and uniting under the common theme of being people who like to have fun. Hence the phrase "Let the Good Times Roll!"

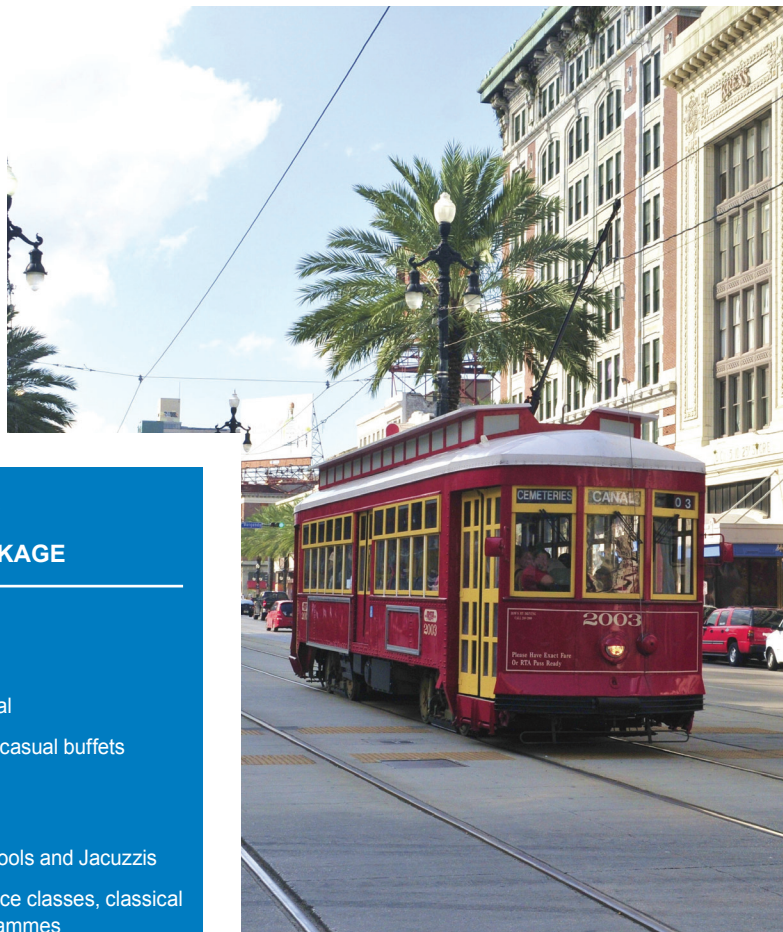

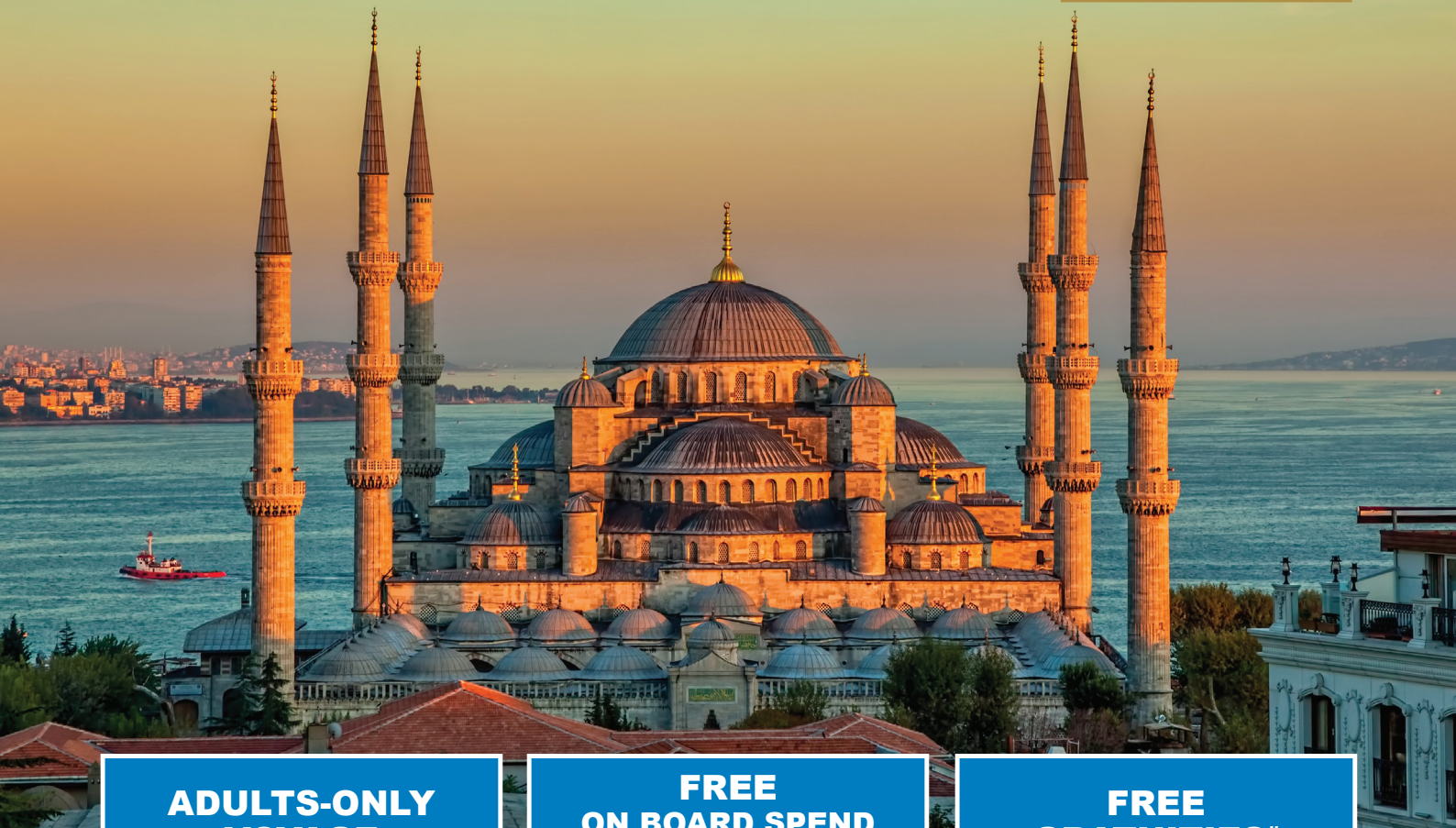

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

I've always thought designing a cruise ship would be great fun but coming up with a name? Now that would be really testing. A name, after all, has to be all things to all people - catchy, simple and, preferably, unique.

So while I like the names Seabourn has chosen for its two new ships - Encore and Ovation have a certain uplifting quality - I do wonder why the bosses have picked a name that Royal Caribbean International had already announced for its third Quantum-class ship. When that launches in mid-2016, Quantum Mark 3 will be named Ovation of the Seas.

At least there will be a bit of a gap between the two Ovations as Seabourn Ovation doesn't enter service until spring 2018 (unlike when Carnival, Thomson and Disney launched a 'Dream' one after the other between 2009 and 2011, which led to untold confusion). So first we will have an Encore, launching in late 2016.

At least there are no such conflicts for Holland America and its Dam ships (the suffix that has been on all its ships since 1883). The next to launch - in 2016 - is Koningsdam - note that second 'n' - it nearly caught me out! - which will not only be the line's biggest ship (2,650 lower berths) but heralds quite a few firsts for the company.

There are single and family cabins, the latter with space for up to five people, and Sel de Mer, a new seafood brasserie that will be stocked where possible with fresh fish bought from local markets. There is also a new Grand Dutch Café in the atrium where you can dream you are in Amsterdam and enjoy people-watching over a coffee or Heineken.

Lots of favourites will be back - the Pinnacle Grill, Canaletto, Asian Tamarind and the self-service Lido, but redesigned to have more of a market feel. The Culinary

Arts Centre is also getting a makeover so it can be used for hands-on cooking classes. In the evenings it will transform into a restaurant where diners can watch the chefs prepare their meal.

Lots of favourites will be back - the Pinnacle Grill, Canaletto, Asian Tamarind and the self-service Lido

Koningsdam will be based in Civitavecchia from February to May, when she relocates to Amsterdam in May for an inaugural summer season sailing to the Baltic and Norwegian fjords. On 14th August she'll be visiting Newcastle, South Queensferry and Invergordon on a 14 night cruise to Iceland. Keep an eye out as I suspect there might be a chance to hop on board and have a quick look around.

Big really is beautiful

Seabourn is keeping very tight-lipped about Encore and Ovation (they will





have one deck more than the Odyssey-class ships and hold 604 passengers and I was told Restaurant 2 will be redesigned to make it more diner-friendly, but that is all we know).

There's no such reluctance on the part of Regent Seven Seas Cruises, which took me to New York for a couple of nights in January to hear about the swanky Regent Suite on new ship Seven Seas Explorer.

It is certainly one impressive piece of Real Estate. Not only for its size - 3,875 square feet, which totally eclipses the Queens Grill Grand Duplex suites on Cunard's Queen Mary 2 - but it comes with its own sauna, steam room, heated loungers and free spa treatments.

It has a piano (and you can have someone to play it!), large marble bar and shares the captain's view over the front of the ship from the Vista Garden (actually just a name; they haven't gone down the Royal Caribbean route

John Challis and Sue Holderness, to give the actors their real names, will be joined by Jeffrey Holland from Hi-Di-Hi and Sue Hodge, who played the diminutive Mimi Labonq in Allo, Allo, during some fun TV-style interviews.

Lovely jubbly, as Del Boy would have said.

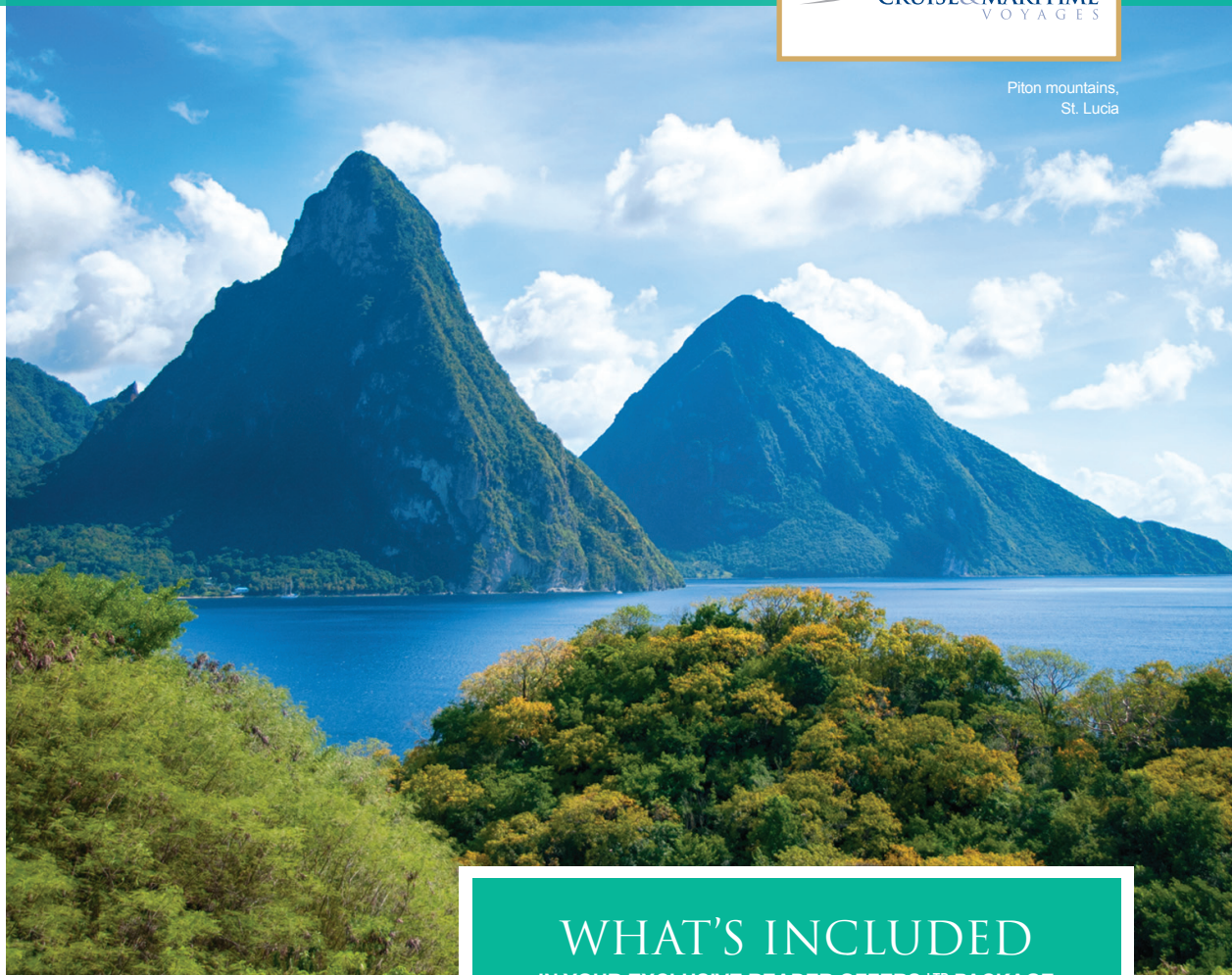

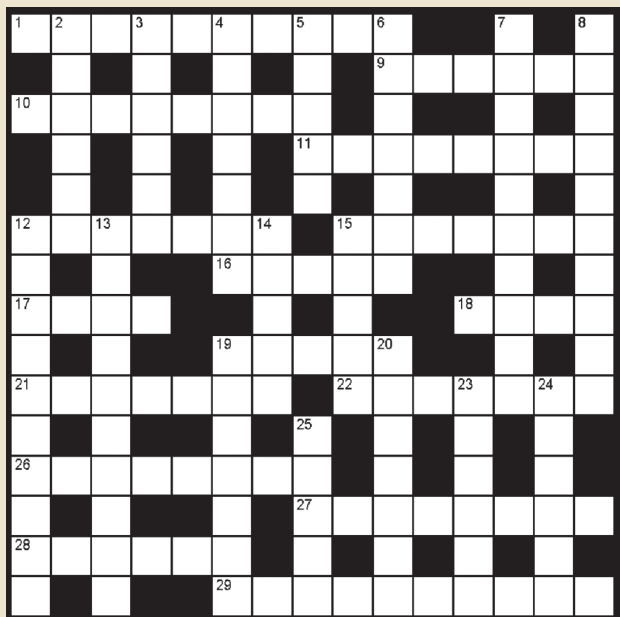

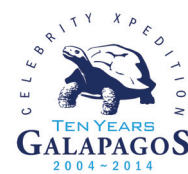

Home to one of the region's most often photographed views and a spectacular geologic setting, Bartolomé Island's barren volcanic landscapes, spatter cones and pinnacle rock make for a unique stop. It is also home to the endemic Galápagos penguin and provides an excellent opportunity for snorkelling
Excursion options include a hike up some 368 stairs 'to the top' of the volcano, a Zodiac ride and an optional beach swim or snorkel

- Day 7** Las Bachas, Santa Cruz Island (am)
This is one of the most beautiful white sand beaches in all of the Galápagos, and behind it are two small ponds that often have flamingos feeding in the shallows. It is also one of the largest nesting areas for the Pacific green sea turtle

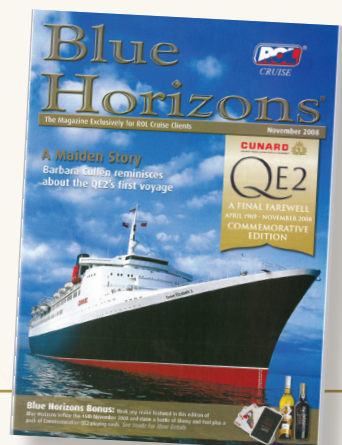

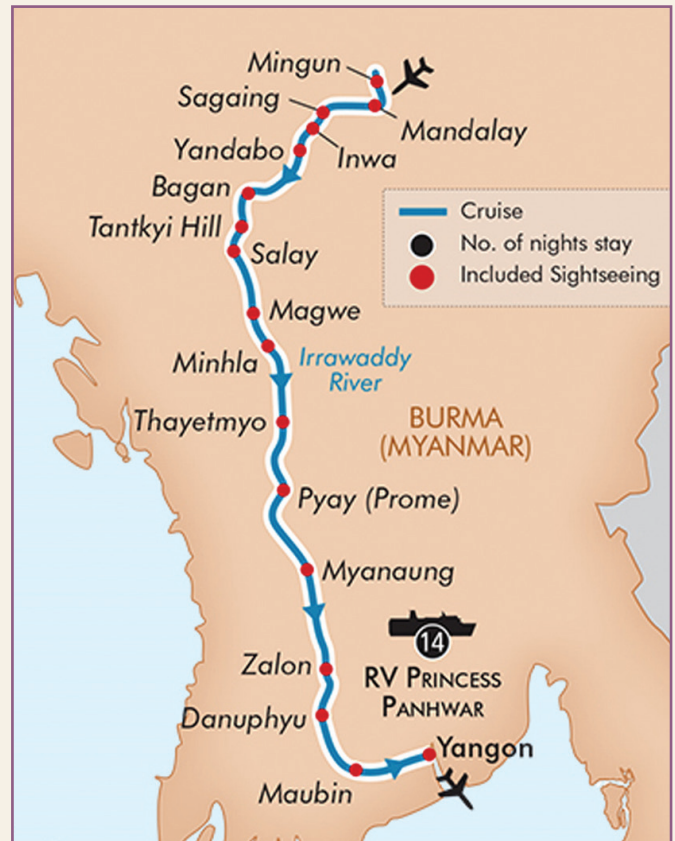

INGREDIENTS

- A good beef fillet (preferably Aberdeen Angus) of around 1kg/2lb 4oz
- 500g/1lb 2oz pack puff pastry, thawed if frozen
- 100g of raw foie gras (alternatives include ground pork sausage or prosciutto for example)
- 1 to 2 egg yolks
- 250g chestnut mushrooms
- 100ml of French Sauternes or white wine
- 3 tbs olive oil
- 50g butter
- 1 large sprig fresh thyme
- Salt and pepper to season

METHOD

1. Heat your oven to 220°C/fan 200°C/gas 7. Sit the fillet on a roasting tray, brush with 1 tbsp of oil, season, then roast (15 mins for medium-rare; 20 mins for medium). When the beef is cooked, remove from the oven to cool, then chill in the fridge for 20 mins.
2. Chop the mushrooms as finely as possible to produce a coarse mixture. You can use a food processor to do this, but make sure you only pulse-chop them.
3. Melt the butter and remaining oil in a large pan. Fry the mushrooms with the sprig of thyme and a dash of salt and pepper, stirring for about 10 mins, then pour in 100ml Sauternes or white wine and cook for a further 10 mins, or until the wine has been absorbed. The mixture should hold its shape when stirred. Remove from the pan to cool, discarding the thyme.
4. Dust the work surface with flour. Roll out a third of the 500g pack of puff pastry to a 18 x 30cm strip and place on a non-stick baking sheet. Roll out the remainder of the pastry to about 28 x 36cm. Spread some of the foie gras and mushrooms down the smaller strip (leaving a gap along the edges), onto which the beef will sit.
5. Retrieve the beef fillet from the fridge and coat the sides and top in the foie gras, followed by the mushrooms. Set in the fridge for another 5 mins.
6. Remove the fillet from fridge and place onto the middle of the smaller pastry strip.
7. Using a rolling pin, carefully lift and drape the larger pastry sheet over the fillet, pressing into the sides. Trim the joins to about 4cm. Seal the rim with the edge of a fork and glaze all over with egg yolk. Using the back of a knife, mark the beef Wellington with long diagonal lines taking care not to slice open the pastry. Chill for at least 30 mins and up to 24 hours.
8. Prepare your vegetables and potatoes, or whichever sides you prefer.
9. Heat your oven to 200°C/fan 180°C/gas 6. Brush the Wellington with a little more egg yolk and cook until golden and crisp (20-25 mins for medium-rare beef; 30 mins for medium). Allow to stand for 10 mins. Vegetables may be cooked in time, potatoes will have needed longer.
10. Serve in thick slices. If you wish, finish with a drizzle of beef bouillon and onion gravy.

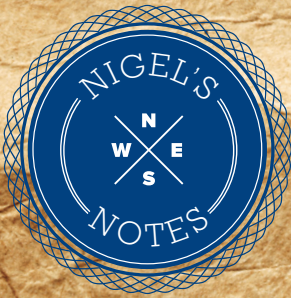

The travel industry is a relatively modern business sector, with organised passenger transport essentially a 19th century development, and holidays a 20th century introduction. Cruise lines are mainly a post Second World War concept, although a few key players have grown from earlier transport-based origins.

P&O Cruises lay claim to the longest history, with their year of foundation generally accepted to have been 1837, when the Peninsular Steam Navigation Company was formally established. Close behind come Cunard, who this year celebrate their 175th anniversary since the 1840 start of liner services. Both these veteran lines are of course now part of the rather more modern Carnival Corporation.

It was in 1848 that the Norwegian Olsen family first set sail with shipping services to the British Isles; the foundation of a wide-ranging global business which is still family-owned and includes UK based Fred. Olsen Cruise Lines.

At the time of writing we have just returned from an Indian Ocean voyage aboard "Balmoral", enjoying some scorching hot winter sunshine!

During a few days in Dubai prior to embarkation we took the opportunity to whizz up the Burj al Khalif skyscraper, which now boasts the world's highest observation gallery on the 148th floor - rather challenging for Sonja's vertigo! Being honest, apart from the sheer height which like the view from an aircraft, there is little of interest to see - just a lot more tall buildings surrounded by endless desert or sea....

Whilst on the cruise we had anticipated ticking off yet another country - Sri Lanka - but on the day the harbour swell in Galle was too risky for tendering, so the call

was aborted. Maybe another day....

One unusual call was to Port Blair in the remote Andaman Islands. This Indian archipelago, composed of numerous little islets, is home to many indigenous tribes, some still not properly in contact with the modern world.

Our return, after a couple of days shopping and dining in Kuala Lumpur, was via Hong Kong's new airport. The original city centre one was quite an experience, as we used to fly in between blocks of flats, all festooned in laundry, then thump down onto the rather short runway.

I recall seeing the tail fin of a plane which had overshot poking out of the harbour waters on one occasion.
